### **The Opening**

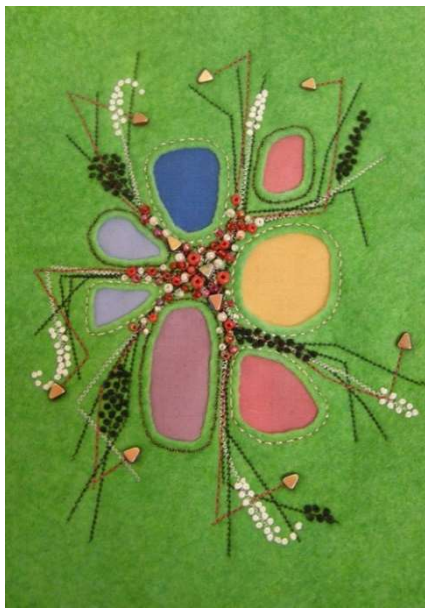
The exhibition was opened by Miles Green, the local historian and author of the book "Penn's Medieval Floor Tiles".
